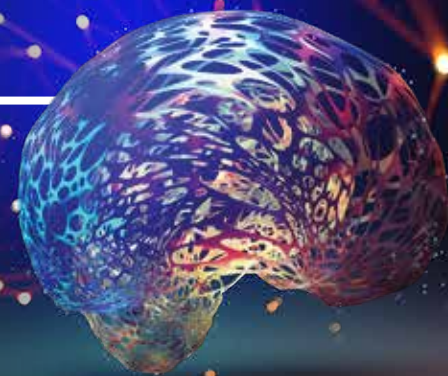

What is this strategy about?

Recognising Generative AI's (GenAI) potential for accelerating the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, the UNFPA Independent Evaluation Office has developed a pioneering strategy for leveraging the benefits of responsible and ethical GenAI for evaluation, while minimizing risks.

What is the purpose of the strategy?

Drawing on an assessment of GenAI use cases in evaluation, the strategy outlines a roadmap to optimize evaluation processes and products with ethical and responsible use of GenAI tools. This approach aims to achieve greater efficiency, effectiveness, and timeliness in evaluations. The strategy also promotes responsible and ethical GenAI-powered evaluation through global advocacy and partnerships, with a particular focus on the Global South.

What are the key features of the strategy?

Provides a framework for recognizing and mitigating challenges and risks in GenAI use in evaluation
